<p><b>Reading</b> I can make and justify predictions with evidence. Using a story that you are reading, write a prediction of what you think will happen next. Explain why you have predicted it. Once you have made the prediction, continue to read the story to find out if you were right.</p>	<p><b>Measure (Assessed)</b> I can measure lengths (cm/m/mm). <a href="#">Measuring in cm.</a> <a href="#">Length Game</a> Choose 10 items around your house. Estimate their length and write it down with the appropriate sign. <p><b>Writing</b> I can make deliberate, ambitious word choices to add detail. <a href="#">'Moving house'</a> Write a short story about the image using the title 'Moving house'. Here is the story opening.... It's always difficult moving house, but not usually as slow as this. Sometimes they regretted buying a house on top of a giant tortoise.
