Draw them on a piece of paper and label each side with the correct measurement. Do the same with larger objects and a tape measure. What is the biggest thing in your home? Measure to see if you are right.</p>	<p>Science I can talk about ways an animal is suited to its environment. Work through the BBC Bitesize page about adaptation. Draw an animal in detail and label the special features that helps it survive.</p>
<p>Reading I can predict what might happen in a story, justifying it with evidence from the text. Find a book at home that you have not read before. Read only the first half of it (not the end). What do you think will happen next? Use the text to support your explanation for why you think this will happened.</p>	<p>Focus/subheading I can find the perimeter of a shape. Complete the lesson from the Oak National Academy about finding the perimeter of a 2D shape.</p>	<p>Physical I can communicate an idea with my dance moves. Watch the video showing Diwali dancing. Create your own dance to show how you celebrate something important to you. It could be your birthday, or perhaps a holiday. Make sure you use the dance to show some of the things that you like to do.</p>
<p>Writing I can create detailed characters to engage the reader and add atmosphere. Read through the BBC Bitesize lesson about describing characters. Complete the activities and create an interesting, engaging character.</p>	<p>Focus/subheading I can convert between various units of measurement. Watch the video about equivalent lengths mm and cm. Pause the video to answer the questions.</p>	<p>History I use dates and terms accurately. Explore this website again. Choose one of the wonders and pick key events in its history. Place these key events in time order and show them using a timeline.</p>
<p>Word, sentence, grammar I can use all the necessary punctuation in direct speech. Read through the BBC Bitesize lesson about using punctuation. Complete the activities.</p>	<p>Focus/subheading I can convert between various units of measurement. Watch the video about equivalent lengths m and cm.
