Communication, Language and Literacy:

Reading – Apply knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes to read aloud fluently. Check a text makes sense. Discuss words and phrases that capture the reader’s interest and imagination.

**Mathematics:
Handling Data**

- Interpret and present data in bar charts, pictograms and tables.
- Solve one-step and two-step questions using information.

Fractions

- Identify equivalent fractions.
- Compare and order fractions.
- Find fractions of an amount.
- Add and subtract fractions.

Geometry

- Recognise, describe and identify angles, lines, 2D and 3D shapes.
- Identify lines of symmetry.

Theme:

- Understand that the lives of people in a historical period were not all the same.
- Begin to give clear and detailed reasons why key events happened or historical people acted as they did.
- Understand the views of others by looking at images, people and places from a different angle.

Science:

- Select and use a range of simple equipment and say if it is suitable to construct simple working circuits.
- Draw working circuits clearly and recognise conventional symbols for electrical components.
- Construct simple circuits to investigate whether materials are electrical conductors or insulators.
