Communication, Language and Literacy:

Reading – Hear and understand rhyming words. create and continue a rhyming string. Hear and say the initial sounds to words and know which sounds are made from which letters.

Writing – Know that letters and words give meaning and begin to give meaning to their own marks. Write their own name and attempt other words, linking the letters and sounds that they know.

Speaking and Listening – Maintain attention, concentrates and sits quietly during appropriate activities. Uses talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events.

Handwriting – Understand that making marks can give meanings and begins to use the correct letter formation to write letters and words.

Mathematics:

- Match and sort pairs

- Recognise and name numerals 1-10
- Count objects to 10 confidently

How you can help at home:

- Encourage your child to be independent, e.g. carry their own bags, cut up food
- Make links with letters/words and sounds by sharing books and songs
- Help your child learn word walls (High frequency words) by sight
- Count a variety of things to 10, e.g. steps, cars, vegetables for dinner
- Talk about family traditions and how they may have changed over time

Expressive Art and Design:

- Construct with a purpose in mind using a variety of resources
- Explore the different sounds of instruments
- Begin to build a repertoire of songs
- Create simple representations of events, people, and objects
- Play cooperatively as part of a group to develop and act out a narrative

Understanding the world:

- Look closely at similarities, differences, patterns and changes through time
- Understand past and present
- Know about similarities and differences among families, communities and traditions
- With help, complete a simple computer program
