Communication, Language and Literacy: Traditional tales and fables, instructions and poetry.

Handwriting – Correctly form letter families. Develop control and accuracy over letter shapes, size, joins and finger spacing.

Place Value

- · Use a place value chart.
- Count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.
- · Partition numbers to 100.
- · Estimate numbers on a number line.

Addition and Subtraction

- Add and subtract 1s.
- Add three single digit numbers.
- Know 10 more / less than a given number.

Shape

- · Recognise and sort 2D and 3D shapes.
- Count sides and vertices of a 2D shape.
