You tube videos for P4C

Watching a short video is a great way to stimulating thinking and talking about things that are relevant to everyone.

- **Before watching** - ask all participants to pick out one of:
 - one interesting thing
 - one thing they like and one thing they don't like
 - a big idea to talk about.
- **After watching** - ask individuals or small groups to turn thoughts into questions to get everyone thinking.
- **Start discussion** - vote to decide which questions to talk and think further about - then get talking!
