Reception and Key Stage 1

Discovery Safari

Guided learning walk with a focus on a selection of animals
(Choose your favourites or let us plan for you)

- What do they eat?
- How do they get around?
- What are their super powers?



PLUS: A surprise encounter in the Secret Garden!

Move-it, Groove-it!

Get your youngsters in the animal groove with this entertaining, animal focussed guided learning trail

- Learn to dance like a flamingo, and waddle like a penguin
- Swing like a gibbon
- Prowl like a lynx ... and much more!

PLUS: Cool off with animal yoga in the Secret Garden

Key Stage 2

The Tail Trail

A fun guided walk to develop an understanding of how animals have adapted to their habitats, by considering different animal tails and their functions

- Which animal uses its tail as a rudder?
- Whose tail is an extra limb?
- Whose tail is the smelliest?

PLUS: Pin the tail on the animals in the Secret Garden ...



World Wildlife Tour

In just one trip to Ballaugh you can encounter animals from all around the world. Take a guided trail on the world map and have your mind blown by the diversity of the animal kingdom!

- Are all penguins from the South Pole?
- Do all monkeys live in the Amazon?
- Where is the world's BIODIVERSITY HOTSPOT?

PLUS: "What On Earth?" in the Secret Garden - a special look at some items from the Wildlife Park's collection of incredible biofacts from around the world.

Monkey Business

This fascinating learning walk will introduce the children to our closest relatives in the animal kingdom.

- Do you know the difference between apes, monkeys, and prosimians?
- What's the difference between "old world" and "new world" monkeys?

PLUS: A fascinating look at replica skulls and interesting primate adaptations in the Secret Garden

Bird Brains!

Apart from beaks and feathers, there's a lot more to birds than you would ever imagine. Discover some truly amazing birds on this guided learning walk

- Discover the amazing superpowers of penguins
- See beaks that can hold three gallons of water!
- Learn about the dazzling dating dance of flamingos

PLUS: A close-up look at some amazing eggs, feathers and beaks in the Secret Garden

Secondary School Groups

Safari Challenge

Keep your students busy with a challenging and fun self-guided quiz that incorporates all the Park's animals.

- Learn about biodiversity, habitats, conservation, food webs and more – while having a great day outdoors around the Wildlife Park
- Work in teams if you choose, to introduce a competitive edge as you complete the challenge
