This <a href="#">game</a> will help you remember analogue and digital times.</p>	<p><b>Physical</b> I can pace myself during challenges and design my own challenges/competitions for stamina.</p> <p>Choose and complete your favourite physical activity from the ones you have done over the past few weeks.</p>

<p><b>Word, sentence, grammar</b> I can use relative clauses in my writing.</p> <p>Complete this <a href="#">lesson</a>. Have you used relative clauses in your piece of writing? Edit your writing to include some relative clauses.</p>	<p><b>Time</b> I can solve problems involving 12 and 24 hour clock.</p> <p>Have a go at this <a href="#">game</a> where you have to calculate to find the start time.
