If you are able to, you could also download the App Story Cubes onto a device. Choose the number and type of dice from the menu. Shake the device to generate new dice pictures. Find a torch, and an empty box, cereal box or something similar. Make a small hole in the side, shine the torch through the hole and then look through from the side to see how the light travels. Draw and label a diagram to show what is happening. What happens if you change the angle of the torch shining through the hole? Does it shine around a corner? Put an object in the box. Does the light go around the shape? Record or explain your findings to someone.</p>
