Complete this activity first and then try this one.</p>	<p>Geography I can identify links between human activity and the impact on environment. Scroll down to activity 2 where does our food come from. Complete one activity sheet.</p>
<p>Word, sentence, grammar I can include adverbial phrases clarifying relationships in time and space. Follow this link to find out about the different types of adverbials. Choose ideas from this sheet to write some of your own sentences using different types of adverbials.</p>	<p>Measures: Time I can solve problems involving 12-hour and 24- hour times. Try this game where you have to find the start time. Then play this word problem solving game.</p>	<p>Creative I can experiment with colour, pattern, shape to create different effects to suit the purpose of my work. Create some pebble pals and write some eco messages on them.</p>
