<p>Speaking and Listening I am beginning to evaluate qualities of the speaker's voice that contribute to impact.</p> <p>Choose a poem or short story to read aloud. What different voices can you use to make it sound more interesting for a listener? If you can, record yourself. Do you sound like you thought you would?</p>	<p>Decimals I can divide 1 or 2-digit numbers by 100 Home Learning - Year 4 (Week 2, lesson 5, not 'Summer Term')</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the activity sheet Practise decimal numbers here and here.</p>	<p>Science I can put forward my own ideas about how to investigate an idea or find an answer to a question</p> <p>Imagine you are going on a picnic and want to take ice for your drinks. What will you wrap the ice in to slow down melting? Plan an investigation to find which materials make the best insulators. Include: question, prediction, equipment and materials, what to keep the same/change (fair test) and a table of results.</p>
<p>Reading I can find reasons in a text to explain how or why something happens.</p> <p>Start here and scroll to 'Video support: What is comprehension?' Read with an adult, then take turns to ask questions to check understanding. Try this and use the words in the text to explain your thinking/answers.</p>	<p>Decimals I can make a whole number Home Learning - Year 4 (Summer, week 1, lesson 1)</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the activity sheet.</p>	<p>Physical I know how exercise affects the body.</p> <p>Before you begin, record how you feel (E.g. calm, relaxed, etc.) Follow the GoNoodle exercises then record again how you feel again (e.g. Excited, tired, breathing faster...) How was your body affected by exercise?</p>
<p>Writing I can organize events into a clear beginning, middle and appropriate end.</p> <p>Go to the story starter and continue the story. Use paragraphs for each idea and organise your writing. Include some dialogue with speech marks.</p>	<p>Decimals I can write decimals Home Learning - Year 4 (Summer, week 1, lesson 2)</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the activity sheet.</p>	<p>Art/Geography I can draw conclusions from my findings.</p> <p>Create an engaging poster to encourage others to protect the environment.
