<p>Speaking and Listening I can use intonation to interpret punctuation and emphasise meaning.</p> <p>Choose a section in your reading book. Read it aloud to an adult or sibling. Take note of punctuation: stop at full stops, pause at commas, and think about how the sentence will sound if it ends in an exclamation mark or a question mark. Practise before you read it aloud so you can show the use of punctuation in your speech.</p>	<p>Comparing Fractions I can compare fractions. Home Learning - Year 3 (Summer Wk 1/lesson 3) Watch the video and complete the activity sheet.</p>	<p>Science I know some of the ways that animals and plants rely on each other in a habitat.</p> <p>Watch How do ecosystems work? Plants rely on animals like bees to spread their pollen, so they can make new seeds. Design a flower that is really bright and colourful to attract insects. Place it in a window or outside if you can. Make a tally of how many insects visit your flower over the day.</p>
<p>Reading I can talk about characters from a story in detail.</p> <p>Reading a book of your choice, choose one character and draw a detailed picture using information from the book. What else do you know? Write it down, including anything you know about their personality.</p>	<p>Comparing Fractions I can compare fractions. Watch How do I compare different fractions? Create your own food story like Snoot's alien meal and compare the fractions.</p>	<p>Physical I can follow a set of instructions.</p> <p>Not all physical exercise is designed to tire us out. Watch Popcorn the Dolphin A Cosmic Kids Yoga Adventure! Do you feel calm and relaxed after? What other things can you do to feel calm and relaxed?</p>
<p>Writing I can describe at least one main character, with precision.</p> <p>Watch Creating Characters. Think about the questions asked in the video to create your own character. How old are they? What do they like, and dislike? Think about questions you can ask too. E.g. Do they have any special talents? Write a detailed paragraph about your character, using as much description as you can.</p>	<p>Comparing Fractions I can compare fractions. Matching Fractions Play the interactive game to match and compare the fractions. Can you create your own fractions matching game to play with your family?</p>	<p>Art I can display my learning in different ways.</p> <p>Create a poster to encourage others to look after the environment. Make it colourful, engaging and include key facts and information. E.g. Reduce, Reuse, Recycle! Keep our sea plastic free! You may like to stick it in a window to share with your neighbours and family :)</p>

Home Learning - Year 3 (Summer Wk 1/lesson 4) Watch the video and complete the activity sheet.</p>	<p>Creative I can experiment with making models.</p> <p>Build a model of a perfect garden for wildlife at Rushen Primary School using your design from last week. Try Lego, a shoebox, scrap paper. Try to recycle things you have in your house.</p>
<p>Spelling I can spell words ending in -less.</p> <p>Read through examples of words ending in -less. Practise these spellings using your spelling menu.</p>	<p>Multiplication I can recall key multiplication facts. Multiplication Houses Follow the steps to create an interactive multiplication house to practise key multiples.</p>	<p>Social Play this game with your family: One of you thinks of an emotion - do not reveal this to your partner! This player then performs a movement to represent this emotion. The other player must try and guess this emotion. Repeat, swapping roles.</p>
