Science Theme - 'Animals' Talk about animals and how they are similar/different. Use your own experiences, books, the Internet. You could have a minibeast hunt. Make a poster or book to show how animals can be sorted and grouped. E.g. How they move, where they live, number of legs, etc. Or design and create an animal fact file (Include where in the world, habitat, food, features.)
Reading If possible, read some stories by the same author. If not possible, read a book by a favourite author. Discuss the characters, their feelings and actions (see above). Can you understand these and empathise, talk about what they might do / should do next / what you would do? Explain your ideas and the reasons for them as clearly as you can.
