<p>Reading Objectives</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read, share and discuss stories, books, newspapers, magazines. • Listen to stories being read - Oxford Owl, BBC • Identify and explain: pivotal moments giving critical opinion, effective word choices and literary features and genre using Point, Evidence, Explain. • Identify and summarise the key points of non fiction pieces. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read, order, write numbers to 1 million. • Know number bonds up to 100, 1000, 1.0 ie $25 + 75$, $250 + 750$, $0.25 + 0.75$ • Know multiplication and division facts up to 12×12. Use to find out 30×4, 300×4 and 30×40. • Use column methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. • Find simple fractions, decimals and percentages of amounts, e.g 10%, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ 0.25.
<p>Writing Objectives</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make your own story book, write a story, some instructions, an invitation, a shopping list, diary or a letter. Plan it, say it, think it, write it, re-read it to check it. • Include adjectives adjectives, adverbs, similes, metaphors, alliteration, onomatopoeia, relative clauses, personification, expanded noun phrases, different sentence types from Alan Peat. • Use capital letters, full stops, commas for clauses, speech marks, () - ; correctly. • Use connectives / conjunctions to create subordinating clauses. • Learn to spell common irregular words.
