Act it out, taking on the role of a character.• Give your opinion about characters and explain your reasons.• Practise Word Walls to learn to read common, irregular words by sight. (see school website for word lists)• Learn Letters & Sounds to develop phonics skills (see school website for information on phonics progression)	<p data-bbox="1518 375 1816 406" style="text-align: center;">Number Objectives</p> <ul data-bbox="1254 446 2072 630" style="list-style-type: none">• Read, order, write and compare numbers to 10, then to 20.• Explore addition and subtraction facts for numbers to 10, i.e. use objects to explore different ways to make a total of 4... <p data-bbox="1254 638 1377 933">0+4 1+3 2+2 3+1 4+9-5 8-4 7-3 6-2, etc.</p> <ul data-bbox="1254 973 2016 1077" style="list-style-type: none">• Doubles to 5+5.• Practise sharing items around the home into equal groups. <p data-bbox="1254 1125 1489 1157">Useful websites:</p> <ul data-bbox="1254 1165 1971 1228" style="list-style-type: none">• Hit the Button (Doubles)• Mental Maths Train (one more / less, +/- to ten)

Plan it, say it, think it, write it, re-read it.• You could draw and write about your picture, write a story, make your own book, write some instructions, a shopping list, an invitation or a letter).• Include adjectives.• Learn to spell common irregular words from the Word Walls.
