then - They were shopping in town **then** went for something to eat.

when - The sun came out **when** we arrived at the beach.

if - You can come along later **if** you would like to.

or - We can meet tomorrow **or** we can wait until next week.

since - **Since** you can't come out today I'll call you again tomorrow.

while - **While** I was waiting for the bus it began to rain.

although - **Although** he tried hard he couldn't work it out.

but - I waited for my friend **but** she didn't turn up.

however - I like to go on holiday, **however** I don't enjoy flying.
