- S/he enjoyed this book so much that s/he's really looking forward to another story about these characters.

- > S/he seems to be looking carefully at the beginning of the word for clues, but sometimes needs reminding to look at the endings.
- > I'm encouraging him/her to 'guess'/try the words and is getting more confident at doing this.

- S/he is getting used to reading past a word s/he doesn't know and then coming back to work it out.
